

Math Placement

- 1) Students with AP or transfer Math credit will be placed based on the class level of the credit received.
- 2) Students with SAT (or equivalent ACT) will be assigned a Math Level based on these scores. (See chart below) This placement **cannot** be over-ridden. These students **are not** allowed to take the math placement test.
- 3) Transfer students, adult students, or international students who do not have SAT scores or ACT scores and do not have math transfer credit equivalent to MATH 1100, 1103, 1241, 1242, or higher will complete the hard copy math placement test. The math placement test is a 30 minute test with 25 questions (no calculator allowed) and students are assigned a Math Level based on this score. (See chart below)
- 4) Students who place into MATH 0900 will be given the option to complete the online Hawkes Self Remediation program in lieu of enrolling in the MATH 0900 course. Students who choose this option will be assigned to ML2 upon its completion. **Note:** 1. Grades are not assigned and credit hours are not earned when this option is selected. 2. MATH 0900 is for ML1 students only. Students assigned to higher levels should go through the online program if they wish to refresh their algebra skills.
- 5) All math courses, with the exception of MATH 0900, can be used to meet a (P) goal for general education. In some majors, students can take MATH 1102 and/or MATH 1105 to satisfy their (P) goal requirement. These two courses **do not** require MATH 0900 as prerequisite. Students should check with their major departments and advisors to see if they fall into this category. MATH 1340 is for Elementary Education majors or Special Education majors only.
- 6) A student with AP statistics credit will be placed into MATH 1100, unless he/she has other AP math credit or MSAT/ACT scores that can place him/her in higher level mathematics classes.
- 7) If a transferring student has transfer credit in MATH 1102 or in Statistics (but no other math credit), then he/she will be placed according to his/her MSAT/ACT score. If he/she has no MSAT/ACT score, then he/she will take the math placement test.
